

Britishness in History

Students understand the development of key British institutions such as parliament and the rule of law are investigated and returned to, at pivotal points in their history.

Britishness in PE

Students are taught and practice key British values and codes of conduct in sport, such as fair play, teamwork, mutual respect and sportsmanship.

Britishness in ICT

The key role of British scientists, inventors and innovators in the digital world is highlighted and celebrated in KS3 and 4 schemes of work.

Britishness in Music

Students develop an awareness of the power of music, and the effect it can have on an audience to make them think or act differently

Britishness in D&T

Students understand the legal responsibilities of working safely in the classrooms

Britishness in Spanish & French

British life and customs are compared with those in France and Spain. Similarities and differences are identified and discussed. Stereotypes are looked at and the question "What makes us British and what makes the French French" debated.

Britishness in PD

At KS3 and 4 students are taught about the British Parliamentary system, voting systems, rights and procedures. Students also gain an understanding of other faiths .

Britishness in English

Students develop an awareness of different points of view and are able to give a balanced argument. Through the years they grow an appreciation of poetry and literature.

Britishness in Art

Students look at a range of artists and designers both traditional and contemporary. They help students to develop cultural awareness and an understanding of the contribution of British Art and Design over time. They use this information to inform and influence their own Art work.

Britishness in Maths

Students understand the value of currency and budgeting .

Students consider the consequences advantages and disadvantages of things such as environmental damage, ethical decisions relating to how Geography and nature interrelate and the environment is used and abused as well as how themes can be used to change perception, opinion, action and cause reaction.
